



What To Bring

Please Note: All medications must be turned into the Camp Nurse upon arrival, and must be in their original bottle with prescription label intact. The Camp provides a Nurses Station with normal over the counter medications.

Clothes: Please bring modest swimsuits. No bikinis or speedo's. Private areas should be well covered. If it is questionable, please bring a dark shirt and shorts to add additional covering. Tankinis are okay as long as all private areas are well covered and the tops are of reasonable length.

All clothes must be modest by our judgment, and logos or phrases should be appropriate. A good way to understand what we expect for modesty is following two rules we use: 1. We don't want to see any "cracks" coming or going. 2. We don't want to see your underwear or your lack thereof. Additionally, please use common sense when it comes to length of shorts. The super short ladies shorts that are popular in the stores right now are not acceptable.

Personal Articles: Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera, sleeping bag, pillow, bath towel, personal articles (soap, deodorant, toothbrush, etc.), sunscreen, mosquito repellent.

Spending Money For: Shiloh Summer Missionary Offering, Camp T-shirts & Hats- \$10.00 to \$12.00. Water Bottles or Mugs \$5.00 to \$6.00. Hoodies \$20 to \$25.00. **Please Note:** You will be given a limited amount of free treat items from the camp store, you will not be allowed to buy additional treats.

Cabin Leaders remember you will be leading Cabin Devotions each evening, so come prepared.

What to Leave at Home: All forms of Fantasy Games, all forms of alcohol or tobacco and any and all forms of illegal drugs. Any and all matches and lighters. Any and all forms of weapons, including pocket knives. **Electronic Devices & Cell Phones must be turned into the camp office upon arrival. You may check messages once a day if necessary. Please bring a watch and alarm clock other than your cell phone!**

Required Yearly Staff Training

Required Weekly Staff Orientation

Adult Staff: Arrive by 11 a.m. Monday each week to get settled in. Orientation will begin right after lunch at about 12:45 p.m.

Cooks & Kitchen Staff: Arrive by 10 a.m. Monday each week, and the Head Cook will orient you.

Timothy Staff: Arrive by 2 p.m. Monday each week. Your Orientation is at 4 p.m. Timothies may ride the bus to camp for free.

The Timothy Retreat is June 23-25.

Timothies will be receiving a flyer with further information.

Summer Missionary Training & Work Week

June 18-25. Summer Missionaries should plan to be at camp from June 18 on through the last camp. SM's will have 4th of July week off, and may travel home for this week. Traveling home on weekends is allowed with approval.

Volunteer Staff

Would you like to help at camp, but you only have time to volunteer once in a while? We have a place for you! Most of our Camp Staff fit in this category.

What do we need help with?

What are the Requirements?

Those 18 and older must successfully apply to Shiloh.

Those under 18 must be part of the Shiloh Timothy Charge, which is a year round discipleship program (contact Shiloh for information.)

Staff Training is required for all with the exception of Speakers, Cooks, Dishwashers or other kitchen assistants.

Weekly Staff Orientation is required for everyone. (See back page for information on Staff Training and Orientation)

Exception: If you are simply coming to a Work Day, you need not apply or attend any trainings.
