At Shiloh, we don't want to turn anyone away due to finances. Camper assistance funds are available. Please see the camp website for details.

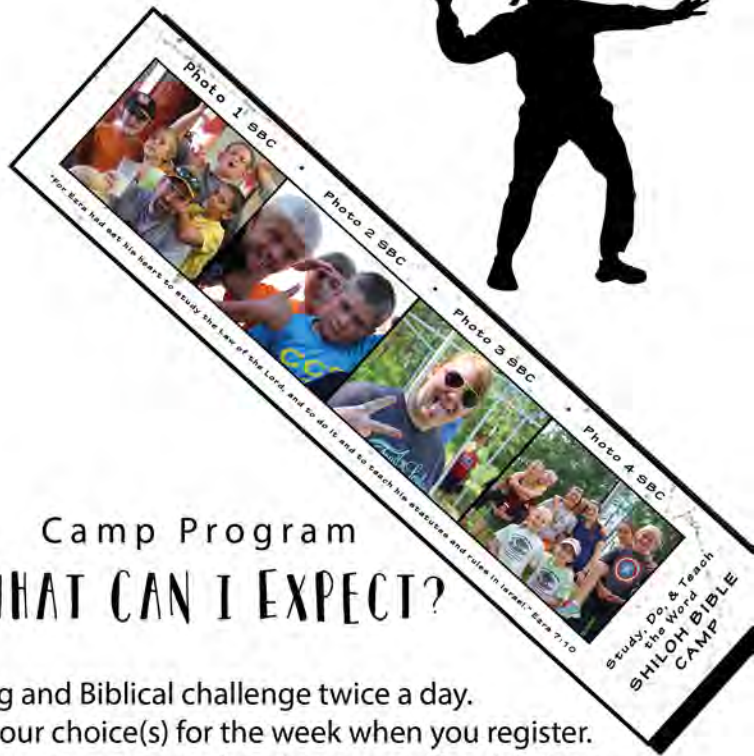

Chapel Times: Singing and Biblical challenge twice a day.

Skills Classes: Make your choice(s) for the week when you register.

Skills Classes

HIGH SCHOOL CAMP

At this camp, campers will be in ONE skills class for two hours each day throughout the week. Classes will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.

ALTERNATING SPORTS CLASS: Class participants will vote on different sport/game activities to play each day.

INTERMEDIATE CANOEING: Advance your canoeing skills beyond the basics. Learn some important skills and enjoy a lot of time on the water.

PRAISE MUSIC CLASS: Bring your favorite band instrument or just show up with your voice. In this class students will learn about leading a music time for a worship service and also play instruments/sing together and learn some songs to perform for the entire camp at the end of the week.

PAINTBALL: In this class, prepare to learn and participate in the exciting sport of paintball. WE WILL PROVIDE all equipment! Please do not bring personal paintball guns! (Additional \$20.00 fee for this Class.)

MEDIEVAL SWORDPLAY: Make your sword, learn the skills, learn the code of conduct, and compete in structured swordplay. (Safety swords & Equipment will be used.)

PHOTOGRAPHY: This class will be a mixture of teaching and explaining beginner concepts of good picture taking, as well as experimenting with the concepts learned. (This class requires that you bring your own digital camera other than a phone camera.)

MINI HORSE OBSTACLE COURSE FUN: Learn about the fun things you can do with Mini Horses! Instruction will include *ground horsemanship training* with obstacles and various training tools. Campers will have the opportunity to learn new abilities, and compete in obstacle courses with their horses. (We will be using Mini Horses in this class, horseback rides will not be available.)

OPTIONAL HIGH SCHOOL RAFTING TRIP!

On Friday, High School campers will have the option of either staying at camp for a special game time followed by regular afternoon free-time activities, OR go on a day-long White Water Rafting Trip for an additional \$48.00 fee.*

WHAT TO BRING

Please note: All medications must be turned in to the camp nurse upon arrival, and must be in their original bottle with prescription label intact. The camp provides a nurses station with normal over the counter medications.

CLOTHES: Modest (see note below) Swimming Suit. (Bikinis or speedos are not allowed.) Casual clothes suitable to camp activities. Be prepared for both warm & cool, sun or rain. Mornings & Evenings can be cold at Shiloh. **Shoes & Extra Shoes.** *Please bring sturdy tennis shoes for game times. Please Note: All clothes & swimming attire must be modest by our judgment. If we judge something as immodest, you will be asked to change or wear additional covering. Use common sense: dress in a modest manner and logos or phrases should be appropriate.*

PERSONAL ARTICLES: Bible, Pen, Notebook, Flashlight, **Camera**, (Cell phones are not allowed to be used as cameras. Bring a regular digital camera or a disposable camera.) **Sleeping Bag**, Pillow, Bath Towel, Soap, Deodorant, **Toothbrush**, Hair Care Items, Sunscreen, Mosquito Repellent, etc.

SPENDING MONEY FOR: Shiloh Summer Missionary Offering, Camp T-shirts & Hats- \$10.00 to \$12.00, Water Bottles or Mugs \$5.00 to \$6.00, Hoodies- \$20 to \$25.00. **PLEASE NOTE:** You will be given a limited amount of free treat items each day from the Camp Store. You will not be allowed to buy additional treats.

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

All Electronic Devices such as music players, movie players, Cell Phones (*not allowed as alarm clocks or cameras either*), games, computers, Internet devices, etc.

All forms of fantasy games

Any & all matches or lighters

Any & all forms of weapons (including pocket knives)

All forms of alcohol or tobacco and any and all forms of illegal drugs

Any "Leave at Home" items will be kept in the Camp Office and returned during Check Out at the end of camp.



CAMP CONDUCT: At Shiloh, as we encourage our campers in their relationship with Jesus Christ, we expect them to maintain a high standard of Christian attitude and conduct. Questionable attitudes or behavior will be referred to the camp leadership for a decision.

Due to the widespread cases of influenza, Shiloh will now be screening campers for Influenza-Like-Illnesses (ILI). If your camper has had a fever with sore throat and/or cough in the seven days prior to camp, we ask that you please do NOT send your child to camp. If your camper has been exposed to an ILI within the past 7 days, we ask that you notify us of this contact. All campers need to be 48 hours "symptom free" (including off of fever-reducing medications) before arriving at camp.

SKILLS CLASS SIGN-UP:

Skill Class sign-ups are handled on a first-come, first-served basis, determined by when we receive your registration. Therefore, pre-registration is important if you wish to secure a certain class. The pre-registration deadline is June 19th.

Place your choice number by the desired skill under the appropriate camp. We will make every effort to honor your first choice(s), but once a class is full, we must defer to your second, third or fourth choice.

3rd & 4th Grade Campers will have **ONE**, one hour skills class this year. Please make three choices in order of preference.

5th-8th Grade Campers will have **TWO**, one hour skills classes. Please make four choices in order of preference.

9th-12th Grade High School Campers will be in **ONE** skills class for two hours each day throughout the week. Please make three choices in order of preference.

Instructor Requirements & Certifications:

Our **Archery** and **Riflery** Instructors are required to be at least 21 years of age and have successfully completed Hunter's Safety & our camp training.

Our **Canoeing** Instructor must be at least 21 years old and have successfully completed training under our Program Director. **Self Defense** Instructors must have appropriate professional Martial Arts Training.

Paintball Skills Instructors must be at least 21 years of age, and have completed appropriate training.
