### Who is Invited:

Summer camps are intended for campers between the ages of 8 and 18. They are designed for those who would like to be introduced to the love of Jesus and all who have a desire to grow in their relationship with Him and have some fun with other campers at the same time. Come prepared to have your faith challenged in chapel times, devotions, fellowship, and skills classes.

### When and Where:

Summer camps will be held at Shiloh Bible Camp between June 16th and July 25th, 2O25. Check-In will be at 2 pm on Mondays and Checkout at 11:3O am on Fridays or Saturdays (depending on the camp).

### How Do I Get There:

The camp is located just outside Donnelly, ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles, then turn North (right) onto Gestrin Rd. and proceed about ¼ mile. Bus transportation will be available for all summer camps.

### **Registration Details:**

Registration for camp can be completed online at shilohbibleconference.com. In order to be considered registered for camp, online registration must be completed in its entirety, unless prior permission is given by the Shiloh Executive Staff. Complete and bring the Canteen Form at the back of this brochure to earn Shiloh Bucks to be used in the camp store.

If your camper has a fever with sore throat, and/or cough in the seven days prior to camp, we ask that you please DO NOT send them to camp. If your camper has been exposed to an influenza like illness in the last seven days, we ask that you notify us of this contact. All campers need to be 48 hours "symptom free" (including off of fever reducing medications) before arriving at camp.

Shiloh's Pathfinder Camp is for campers who are 12 to 14 years old. Campers will participate in chapel and worship, indoor and outdoor activities, Bible quizzing, ultimate challenge, and cabin competitions. Cost for this camp is \$130. Bus transportation is available from the greater Boise area for an additional \$20 each way.



Shiloh's Trailblazer Camp is for campers who are 14 to 18 years old. Campers will participate in chapel and worship, indoor and outdoor activities, Bible quizzing, ultimate challenge, and cabin competitions. Cost for this camp is \$130. Bus transportation is available from the greater Boise area for an additional \$20 each way.

### What to Bring

### Personal Articles:

The essentials include a Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, and camera (cell phones are not permitted as cameras). Don't forget a water bottle, sleeping bag, pillow, bath towel, swim towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, hair care items, sunscreen, and mosquito repellent.

### Clothes:

Modest swimming suit. (Bikinis and speedos are not allowed.) Casual clothes suitable for camp activities. Be prepared for warm & cool temps, sun and rain. Mornings and evenings can be cold at Shiloh. Closed toed shoes. Please bring sturdy tennis shoes for game time. Please note: all clothes and swimming attire must be modest by our judgment. If we deem something to be inappropriate for camp, you will be asked to change or wear additional clothing. All logos or phrases should be appropriate.

### **Medications:**

All medications must be turned into the camp nurse upon arrival and must be in the original bottle with prescription label intact. The camp provides a nurse's station with normal over the counter medications.

### **Spending Money:**

For camp t-shirts, hats, mugs, water bottles, cinch packs, canteen treats, etc. Spending money can be added at time of registration so that campers do not need to carry cash to camp. Cash brought to camp can be deposited at registration to be spent during the week. All unspent money will be returned to the camper at checkout.

### What NOT to Bring

All ELECTRONIC DEVICES Include music players, movie players, cell phones (not allowed as alarm clocks or cameras), games, computers, internet devices, etc.

All fantasy games. All forms of matches/lighters.

All forms of weapons (including pocket knives).

Nuts: Due to the number of campers with nut allergies, we are a nut-free camp.


